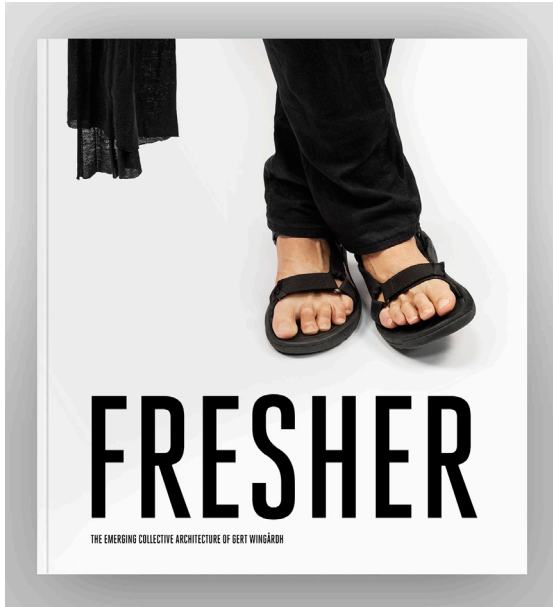


Fresher

A new chapter in the Wingårdhs saga



50 new projects embody the spirit of an office ready to lead the ecological and social revolution.

Included in the book are Wingårdhs projects such as Nationalmuseum, Liljevalchs, Helsingborg Water Tower, Kvarteret Basaren and Malmö Market Hall. Author and literary critic Mark Isitt is editor of the book and has travelled far and wide to interview the people behind the projects and hear their stories. *Fresher* covers over seven years, 50 projects, 287 individuals, 296,000 working hours and includes loads of never-before-seen photos, drawings, models and visualisations.

While Gert Wingårdh, five-time winner of the Kasper Salin Prize, is still the core and key figure of the office and constantly on the hunt for the unexpected, the interview book *Fresher* conveys the image of a tailor-made architectural collective that keeps gaining in strength, and whose multitey serves as a unifying force.
