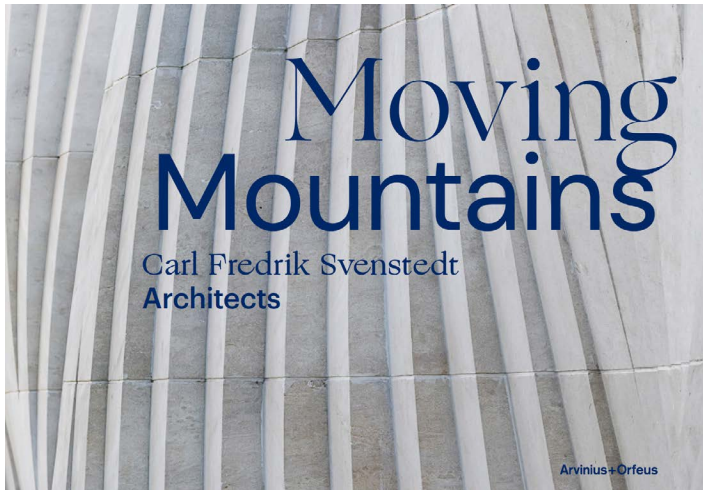


Moving Mountains

And as with all things human, these decisions are far from objective. Our world is built on relative truths. The designer's task is to question the logic that goes into such decision-making, and sometimes to make different choices. The challenge is to reinvent our world, to project a future that does not yet exist. For architects don't actually build buildings: they conceive them.

Carl Fredrik Svenstedt Architects' work challenges gravity in its aspiration for a holistic and lasting beauty. Their built work in France and internationally, presented here along with a collection of unbuilt projects, explore how ideas can become reality.
